 5. The proceedings initiated by the Collector of Nilgiris for repossession of certain plots of land in Coonoor earmarked for public use has been challenged by the company on a Writ Petition filed before Madras High Court and the matter is pending adjudication.
 6. Pursuant to an arbitration award dated 30.9.2017 relating to additional electricity dues of Caustic Soda manufactured sold by the Company in the year 1986 amounting to Rs. 2.31 Crores together with interest at 6% p.a. The Company has challenged the award before the Madras High Court which is pending adjudication.
- In view of the above Note No.4,5 and 6, the Statutory Auditors have drawn attention in the above matters without qualifying their Limited Review report.

Based on our review conducted and procedures performed as stated in paragraph 3 above and based on the consideration of the review report of other auditor, nothing has come to our attention that causes us to believe that the accompanying Statement, prepared in accordance with recognition and measurement principles laid down in the aforesaid Indian Accounting Standards ('Ind AS') specified under Section 133 of the Companies Act, 2013, as amended, and as per the presentation requirements of the SEBI Circulars and other accounting principles generally accepted in India, has not disclosed the information required to be disclosed in accordance with the requirements of Regulation 33 of the SEBI (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015 (as amended), including the manner in which it is to be disclosed, or that it contains any material misstatement.

6. We did not review the interim financial results and other financial information of subsidiaries, whose interim financial results reflect total assets of Rs.13.31 lacs as at June 30, 2020, total revenues of Rs.Nil lacs, total net Loss after tax of Rs.(0.02)lacs total comprehensive income of Rs. (0.02) for the quarter ended June 30, 2020 included in the consolidated unaudited financial results, as considered in the consolidated unaudited financial results. This interim financial result has been reviewed by other auditor, whose report has been furnished to us by the management and our conclusion on the Statement, in so far as it relates to the amounts and disclosures in respect of the subsidiary is based solely on the report of the other auditor and procedures performed by us as stated in Paragraph 3 above. Our conclusion on the Statement is not modified in respect of the above matter.
